Hot Weather Policy

Players play at own risk

Social Play (Tuesday Mornings & Saturday Afternoons):

Sessions will continue as scheduled for those wishing to play. Players will be encouraged to drink plenty of water, stop playing if feeling unwell and make use of the air-conditioned social centre.

Doubles Competition (Thursday Evenings):

Matches will be played as per the fixture. Format of play will be modified to suit the conditions, e.g. reduce playing time, schedule extra breaks, provide ice, etc. Players will be encouraged to drink plenty of water, stop playing if feeling unwell and make use of the air-conditioned social centre.

If on the night playing conditions are considered unfavourable, even after modification of format, the committee reserves the right to cancel the match. Players/teams may play social games if they wish.

The Committee reserves the right to cancel a scheduled match if it considers conditions would be unfavourable. In this instance the Match Committee will advise A Grade Team Captains and all B Grade Players the day before the scheduled match. A notice will be placed on the BVASA website.

Tournaments (March & November Carnivals, Country Events):

Tournaments will go ahead as scheduled. Format of play will be modified to suit the conditions, e.g. reduce playing time, schedule extra breaks, provide ice, provide fans for air circulation along benches, etc.
